# **Suggested Home Learning Activities**

Reading is a massive part of children's education and it is vital we support children to read as soon as possible. Please try to find time to share books with your children everyday and let them see you reading! Pre school continues to have a library day every Wednesday where they can choose a book to take home and share with you. Reception children



have their shared reading session with adults 9:00—9:30 every week. Parents/ Grandparents or other close relatives can come along and see what your child has achieved in reading that week. They can also choose a library book to take home.

### This term we are learning:

During this half term, the EYFS children will be covering a range of exciting topics. In Pre School these will include Firework Safety, Space and Christmas. The Pre School children will also be celebrating nursery rhyme week so please keep practising those nursery rhymes.
